



Disaster Prevention Grant Program

On April 26, 2010, Governor Chet Culver signed an extension of the I-JOBS legislation, including the creation of the Disaster Prevention Grant Program. The program makes available \$30 million for grants to cities and counties to assist in the development and completion of construction of local public buildings in a manner that mitigates damages from future disasters, including flooding. The Iowa Finance Authority (IFA) will administer the program.
